Why might the services passport help?

- ➔ 70% of EU GDP and employment
- ➔ Services face more barriers than goods
- ➔ Economically most significant sectors also most regulated (construction, business services)
- ➔ SMEs enter new markets by the temporary cross-border provision of services



CZ Proposal - Basic Principles

- ➔ True simplification
- ➔ Voluntary
- ➔ Electronic
- ➔ No additional administrative burden
- ➔ Both for Establishment and Cross-border provision of services
- ➔ Applicable in all services sectors



CZ Proposal - Key Features of Fix Part

- ➔ Primary establishment
- ➔ Tax liability
- ➔ Social security
- ➔ Health insurance
- ➔ Criminal liability
- ➔ Professional indemnity insurance



CZ Proposal - Key Features of Flexible Part

- ➔ European Profession Card
- ➔ Voluntary certification (ISO)
- ➔ Membership of professional association
- ➔ A1 form
- ➔ Data concerning employees
